Priority #2—The structure must have been previously owned by a federal, state, or local-governmental entity for no less than six months (https://www2.illinois.gov/dnrhistoric/Preserve/Documents/IL-HTC\_Priority%202.pdf).

Priority #3—The structure must be located in a census tract that has a median family income at or below the Illinois median family income; data from the most recent 5-year estimate from the American Cammunity Survey (ACS), published by the U.S. Census Bureau, shall be used to determine eligibility (*https://www2.illinois.gov/dnrhistoric/Preserve/Documents/lL-HTC\_Priority%203.pdf*). Priority #4—The qualified rehabilitation plan must include in the development partnership a Community Development Entity, a low-profit organization, or a not-for-profit organization, as defined by Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (*https://www2.illinois.gov/dnrhistoric/Preserve/Documents/lL-HTC\_Priority%204.pdf*).

Priority #5—The structure must be located in an area declared under the federal Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act as an Emergency Declaration (pursuant to Title IV of the Act). The declaration must be no older than 3 years at the time of application (*https://www2.illinois.gov/dnrhistoric/Preserve/Documents/IL-HTC\_Priority%205.pdf*).
