Install a larger (wider) sign and center within the sign band. Install an external light source below the sign.

Paint non-historic brick to match the dark green trim color.

EXISTING CONDITIONS

- Paint non-historic brick to match the dark green trim color.
- Replace existing door with historically appropriate door as shown
- Enlarge existing opening and install a historically appropriate door as shown.

Replace existing back porch with new as shown. Perforated metal landing and screening can help disguise the utilities but allow them to be functional.

Relocate or disguise utilities as much as possible. Many can be painted to blend in with the wall.

Brick color to match painted brick on the front. Awning color is Burgundy, style 4631 by Sunbrella. Sign is externally lit by a gooseneck fixture..
