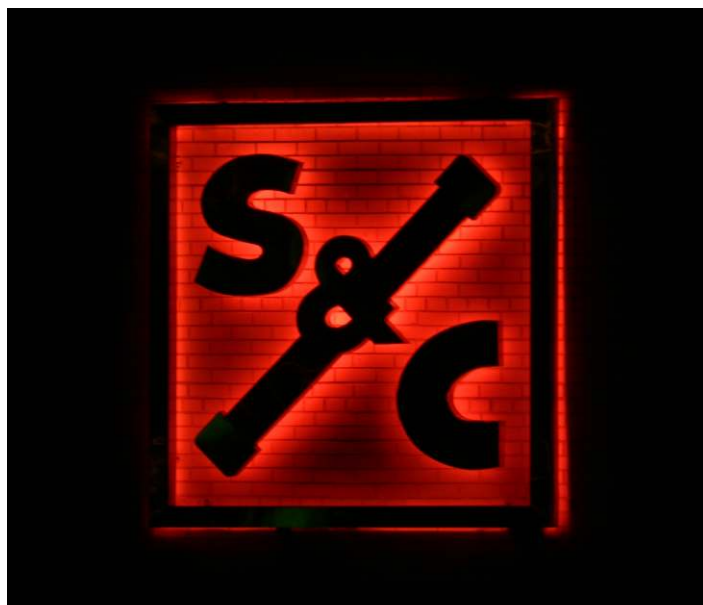




**EXISTING CONDITIONS**

- Remove existing sign and awnings
- Investigate presence of terra cotta behind the modern brick bulkhead prior to storefront replacement
- Install new sign and awning as shown

**PROPOSED DESIGN**

Proposed design is based on the assumption that the historic terra cotta bulkhead has been removed prior to the installation of the existing brick. If the terra cotta exists and can be exposed without being damaged, it should be retained and/or reincorporated into the new design. Proposed design consists of a new operable storefront conducive to outdoor dining. A new reverse channel-set neon (or LED) sign should be installed as shown. Channel letters are set in Helvetica Bold, spaced 100% apart and have a brushed aluminum finish. Proposed awning color is Hartwell Fiesta, style 4973, by Sunbrella.
