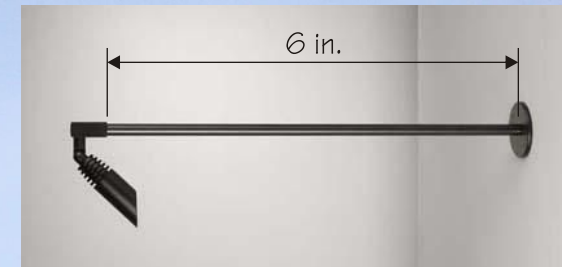


PROPOSED DESIGN

Dimensional cut plastic lettering flush or pin mounted to the building surface. Each word to be centered horizontally with the awnings and vertically within the sign band. Cut plastic to have a matte finish. Font used is called **Imperator**.

Square sign with the monogram of Atlante. Sign on 2nd Avenue is flush-mounted while the sign on 18th Street is projecting. Painted wood or enameled steel board with a dimensional outline of the "a" applied to the surface. Projecting sign to be externally illuminated by two fixtures (Winona Placer Series or equivalent) mounted on either side of the sign, just above the awning. Fixture stem length to be 6".
