## EXISTING CONDITIONS

Rust should be scraped off of steel lintel with a wire brush and lintel should be painted black to match the new color scheme.

Salvaged Vitro-lite or another similar material should be installed to match the existing white Vitrolite.

**chrome** should be installed in vinyl graphics in font – **MicrogrammaDEEBolExt** on the Vitrolite.

A chrome plated bar should be installed under the vinyl — lettering. See the Vitrolite specialist for instructions on attaching metal to glass.

Aluminum should be scraped and repainted black to match new color scheme.

Vinyl window graphics with the business name, address, - and hours of operation should be installed on the display windows and entry door.

-Four New windows should be installed in the historic opening.

-Paint should be carefully scraped from existing Vitro-lite. Vitrolite should be inspected and mastic reapplied where needed.

Historic doors should be retained, repaired as needed and repainted to match new color scheme.
