



EXISTING CONDITIONS

Remove existing metal canopy and signage.

Remove existing storefront including windows, plywood paneling, entry doors, and lights.

Stone should be cleaned with a mild detergent and scrubbed with a nylon bristle brush. Stone should then be painted Shoji White (SW 7042) from Sherwin Williams paints.

Stone band at top of building, window trim and sashes should be painted Cyberspace (SW 7076) from Sherwin Williams paints.

Window lintels and sills should be painted Software (SW 7074) from Sherwin Williams paints.



Four gooseneck light fixtures should be installed over the new sign, similar to Sign Star D (MR16) from B-K Lighting.

New flush-mounted sign with the business logo should be installed centered over the storefronts.

New recessed entry storefronts should be installed. Storefronts should have large display windows, transoms, bulkheads, and historically appropriated doors. Storefronts should be painted to match the color scheme of the building.

Vinyl window graphics should be installed on the display windows and entry doors.
