EXAMPLE OF INCISED, GILDED, GOLD LEAF LETTERING



PROPOSED SIGN

Masonry piers with quoins, capped with cast stone. Caps are sloped to run off water. Piers sit on concrete footings. The sign is made of a black board with incised, gilded, gold leaf lettering. Font used is Palatino Linotype. Sign brackets set into masonry and painted color of the sign. Sign is lit by fixtures set into the ground in front of it. If there is not enough room for ground fixtures, globe fixtures can be placed on top of the piers.
