

EXISTING CONDITIONS

Existing under-sized windows and vinyl siding should be removed. Air conditioner should be relocated to back of building.

Existing plywood over bathroom doors should be removed.

·Sign should be illuminated with an exterior-mounted light fixture. Light fixture should be minimal in design and contemporary in style. Fixture shown is Twin Sign Star Style C (MR16) from B-K Lighting, www.bklighting.com in a black satin finish.

New sign should be flush-mounted to the building, attached by screws through the mortar joints. Sign should be vinyl graphics of business logo attached to exterior-grade plywood or other exterior-grade material. Sign should be cut out of material so there is no background to the sign.

Existing light fixtures should be repaired and refurbished as needed.

Inset panel should be painted to match existing body and trim colors of the building. Colors should be chosen on site so that they exactly match.

PROPOSED DESIGN

COLOR MATCH

Doors should be painted Espalier (SW 6734) from Sherwin Williams paints.

Door trim should be painted Jay Blue (SW 6797) from Sherwin Williams paints.

New, full-size commercial windows should be installed in the historic window openings. Vinyl window graphics should be applied on the windows with the business name and phone number.

Vinyl window graphics should be installed on the entry door, listing the business' hours of operation.
