



EXISTING CONDITIONS

All existing awnings should be removed from building.

Existing backlit plastic signs should be removed from building.

Upper-floor window frames to be painted black to match secondary color palette.

One long flush-mounted sign should be installed over storefront, using new logo design. The center of the sign, "Georgios" should be lit with 3 gooseneck lighting fixtures, Sign Star Style E (A 19) from B-K Lighting finished in black.

Transom panels should be removed and glass installed in the existing frames.

To avoid damaging the limestone, paint should be removed using a mild chemical stripper and nylon-bristle brush. If limestone will be damaged by the paint removal, it should instead be painted a color that closely resembles the limestone's original color.



PROPOSED DESIGN

Existing doors are very residential, they should be replaced with more historically appropriate commercial doors. Wooden doors should have large area of glass, without muttins.

Storefront should be painted Roycroft Copper Red from Sherwin Williams paints.

Recessed panels should be painted Marigold from Sherwin Williams paints.
