HERTAND HERTAND TO SERVICE AND THE SERVICE AND

EXISTING CONDITIONS

- All existing metal siding should be removed from buildings.

 Existing operable and fixed awnings should be removed from storefronts. Center section of facade should be painted Functional Gray from Sherwin Williams Paints to call out the entry.

NOT FOR COLOR MATCH

Concrete block on upper floor should be painted Rookwood Blue Green from Sherwin Williams Paints or a color that matches the storefront.

NOT FOR COLOR MATCH

New fabric banners should be installed on facade to give the upper floor vertical proportions. Colors shown are Charcoal and Tuscan from Sunbrella fabrics.

New signs should be installed for each business in the building using individual letters or graphics printed a sign board and attached to the facade.

PROPOSED DESIGN
