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Instructions for Determining Priority 4: Development Partnership

To achieve Priority 4 (35 ILCS 31/20(a)(4)), the qualified rehabilitation plan must include in the development partnership a Community Development Entity, a low-profit organization, or a not-for-profit organization, as defined by Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. To qualify for Priority 4 for application Round 1, 2024, applicant must provide the following:

- 1. Signed and notarized "Affidavit Regarding Priority 4 for 2024 Round 1 of The Illinois Historic Preservation Tax Credit Program (35 ILCS 31/20(a)(4))," found on pages 3 and 4 of these instructions. The affidavit must provide the NPS project number, name of the entity eligible to achieve this priority (Development Partner), and its organization type. The affidavit must be signed by both the Development Partner and the current applicant, as identified in the most recent NPS-certified Historic Preservation Certification Application component (i.e., Part 2, Amendment, Part 3), and both signature sections must be completed (even if the Development Partner and the applicant are the same) and notarized. Only the current round's affidavit form found on pages 3 and 4 will be accepted.
- 2. Current proof (dated within 24 months of applicant's Part S-3 submittal) that the identified eligible entity is one of the following:
 - a. Community Development Entity (CDE): submit the CDE certification from the U.S. Department of the Treasury Community Development Financial Institutions Fund (CDFI Fund) or a digital printout from the CDFI Fund website (https://www.cdfifund.gov/awards/nmtc) identifying the New Markets Tax Credit Program allocatee as a CDE.
 - b. Low-profit organization: submit a legal document proving the organization is one of the following. The appropriate legal document may vary depending on the state in which the organization was incorporated.
 - i. a "benefit corporation," as defined by the authorizing law in the state in which the organization was incorporated (in Illinois, see <u>Public Act 097-0885</u>), <u>or</u>
 - ii. a "low-profit limited liability company (L3C)," as defined by the authorizing law in the state in which the organization was incorporated (in Illinois, see Public Act 096-0126).
 - c. **Not-for-profit organization** (as defined by IRC Section 501(c)(3)): submit a determination letter from the IRS <u>or</u> a digital printout from the IRS Select Check website (https://apps.irs.gov/app/eos/) identifying the organization as tax exempt. Ensure that the Employer Identification Number (EIN) is included. Below is a sample screen capture of the IRS Select Check website that highlights the information you must verify prior to submittal.

Before including the screen capture with your Part S-3 submittal, verify the following:

- 1. Make sure the organization name and EIN match those listed on the Priority 4 affidavit.
- 2. Make sure the organization is on Publication 78 Data List. "Yes" indicates not-for-profit status.
