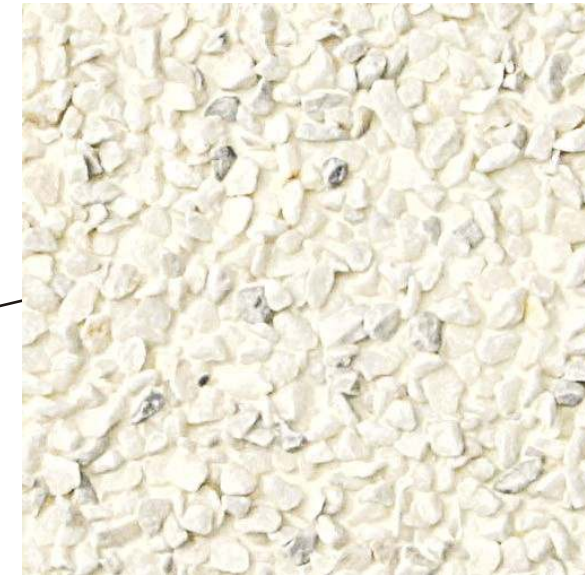

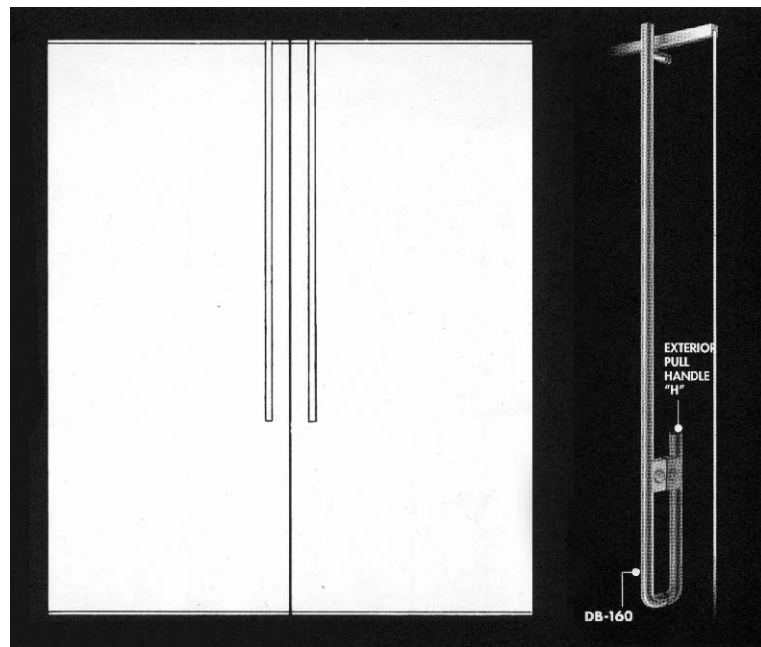
Red reverse channel-set neon or LED housed in black steel channels
