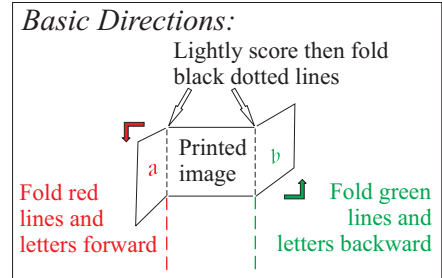


Front of built model



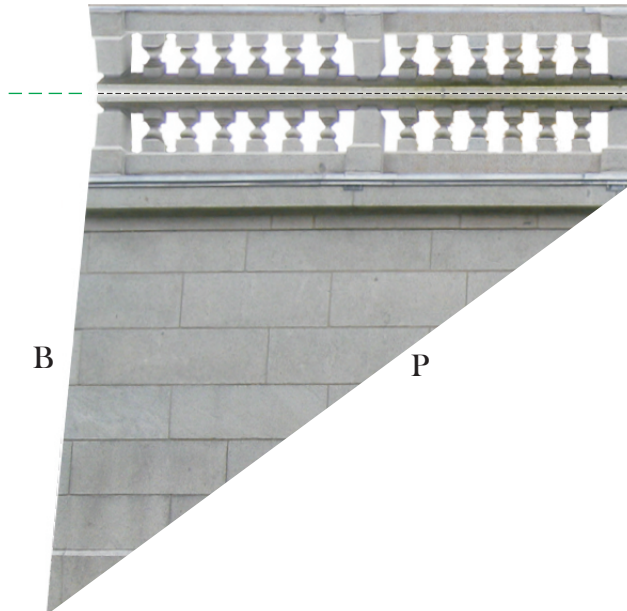
To Assemble Walls and Support Cylinder:

1. Cut out the Front, Back, Right and Left Walls. Cut slits at F14 to F17 and B14 to B17. Fold all dotted lines.
2. Glue the Right Wall balustrade back-to-back so it looks the same on both sides.
3. Glue the Right Wall to the Front and Back Walls using tabs A, C, E, & G. The E and G tabs will be sandwiched by the Front and Back balustrades.
4. Glue the Left Wall balustrade back-to-back so it looks the same on both sides.
5. Glue the Left Wall to the Front and Back Walls using tabs B, D, F, & H. The F and H will be sandwiched by the Front and Back balustrades.
6. Cut out the 2 halves of the Support Cylinder. Form the Cylinder by gluing tabs I & J.
7. Glue in place at I and J on the Right and Left Wall stiffener tabs.

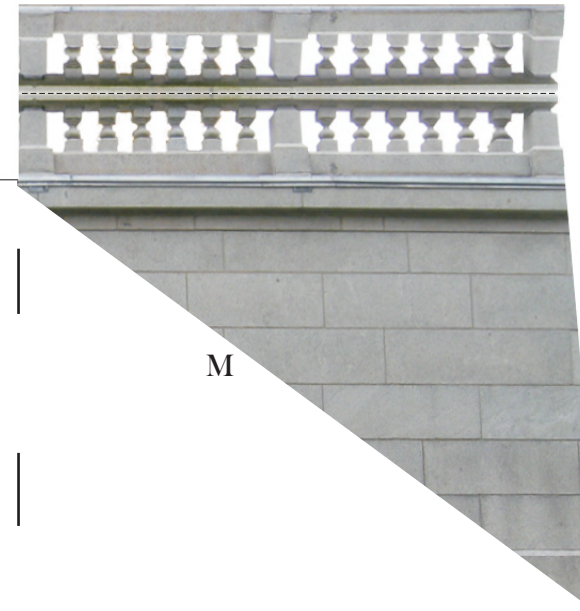

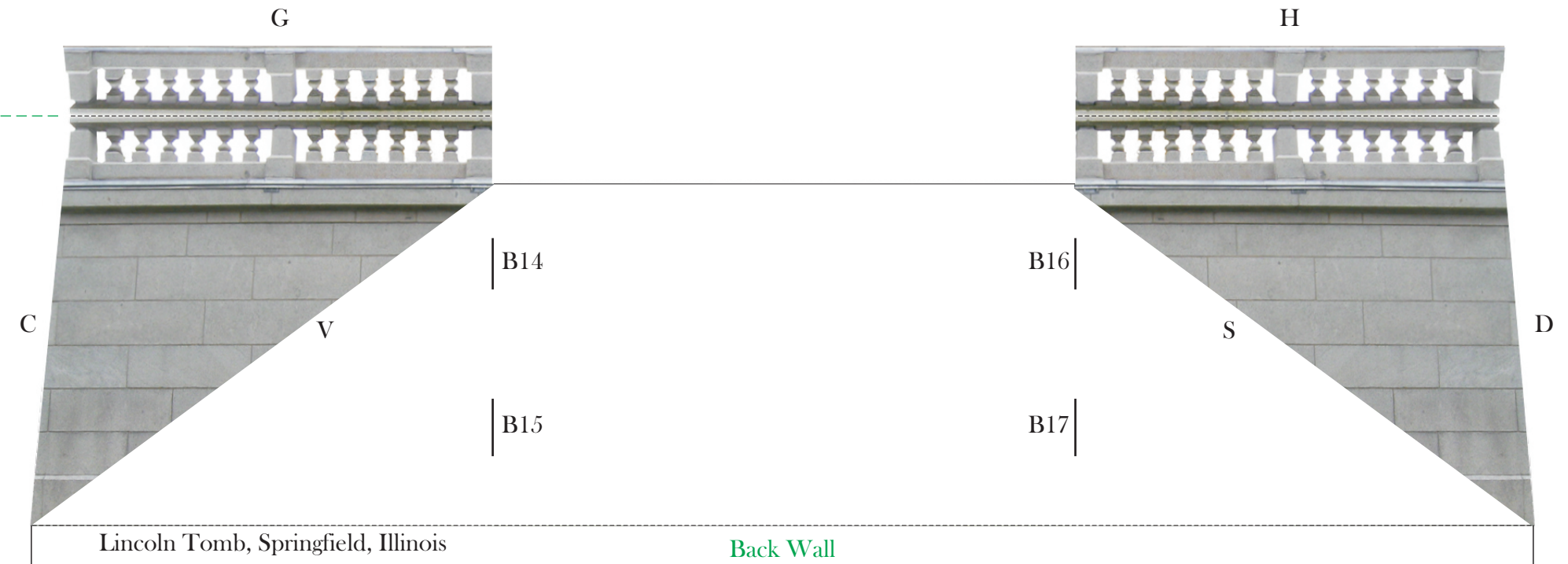
BUILD YOUR OWN LINCOLN SITES

To Assemble Front and Back Semi-Circles and matching Floors:

1. Cut out the Front and Back Semi-Circles and matching Floors. Fold all dotted lines.
2. Glue the Front Semi-Circle balustrade back-to-back so it looks the same on both sides. Form the piece to match the arc of the Floor.
3. Glue the Front Semi-Circle tabs F1 to F 13 to the under side of the Front Semi-Circle Floor.
4. Glue the Front Semi-Circle to the Front Wall by inserting tabs F14 to F17 thru the matching slits and gluing to the back side of the Front Wall.
5. Glue the Back Semi-Circle balustrade back-to-back so it looks the same on both sides. Form the piece to match the arc of the Floor.
6. Glue the Back Semi-Circle tabs B1 to B 13 to the under side of the Back Semi-Circle Floor.
7. Glue the Back Semi-Circle to the Back Wall by inserting tabs B14 to B17 thru the matching slits and gluing to the back side of the Back Wall.

To Assemble Front and Back of the Main Floor:

1. Cut out the Front and Back Main Floor pieces.
2. Glue the Front of Main Floor piece to the Back of Main Floor piece at the tab.
3. Trim slightly as necessary to fit between the balustrades.
4. Glue to the blank floor tabs of the Right and Left Walls.

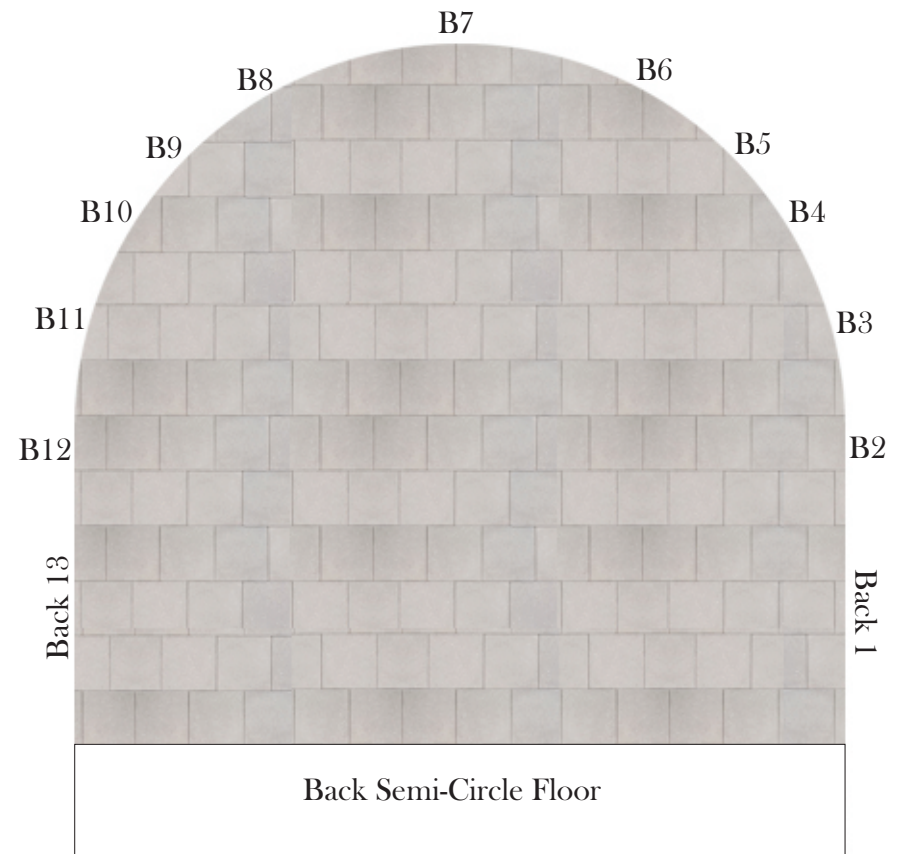
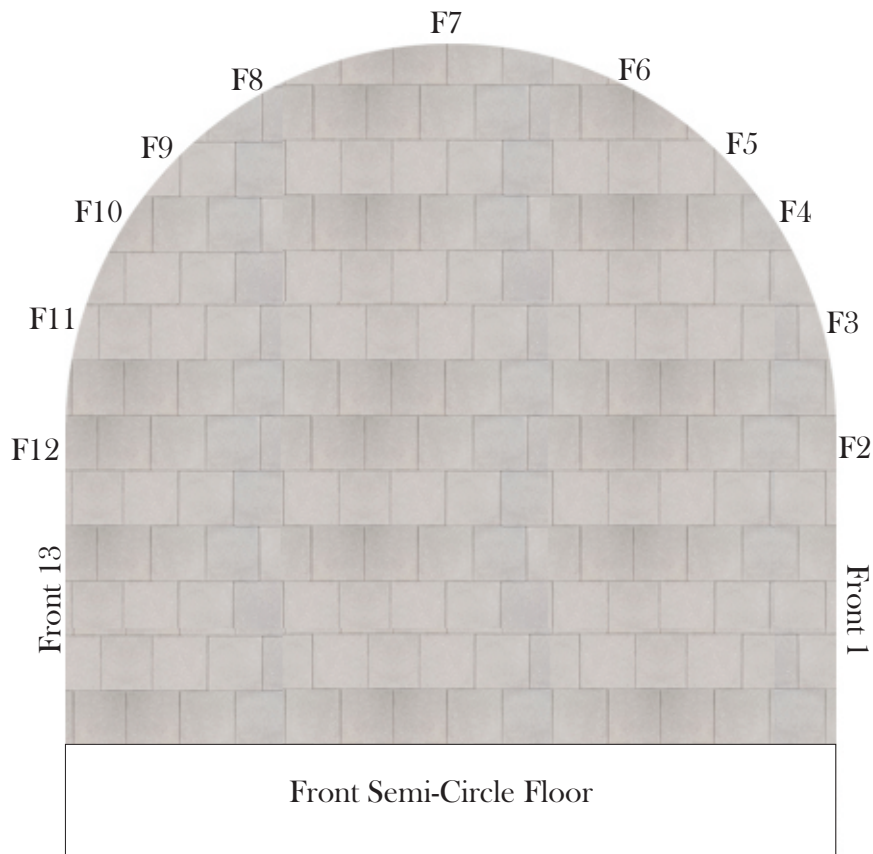
Front Semi-Circle

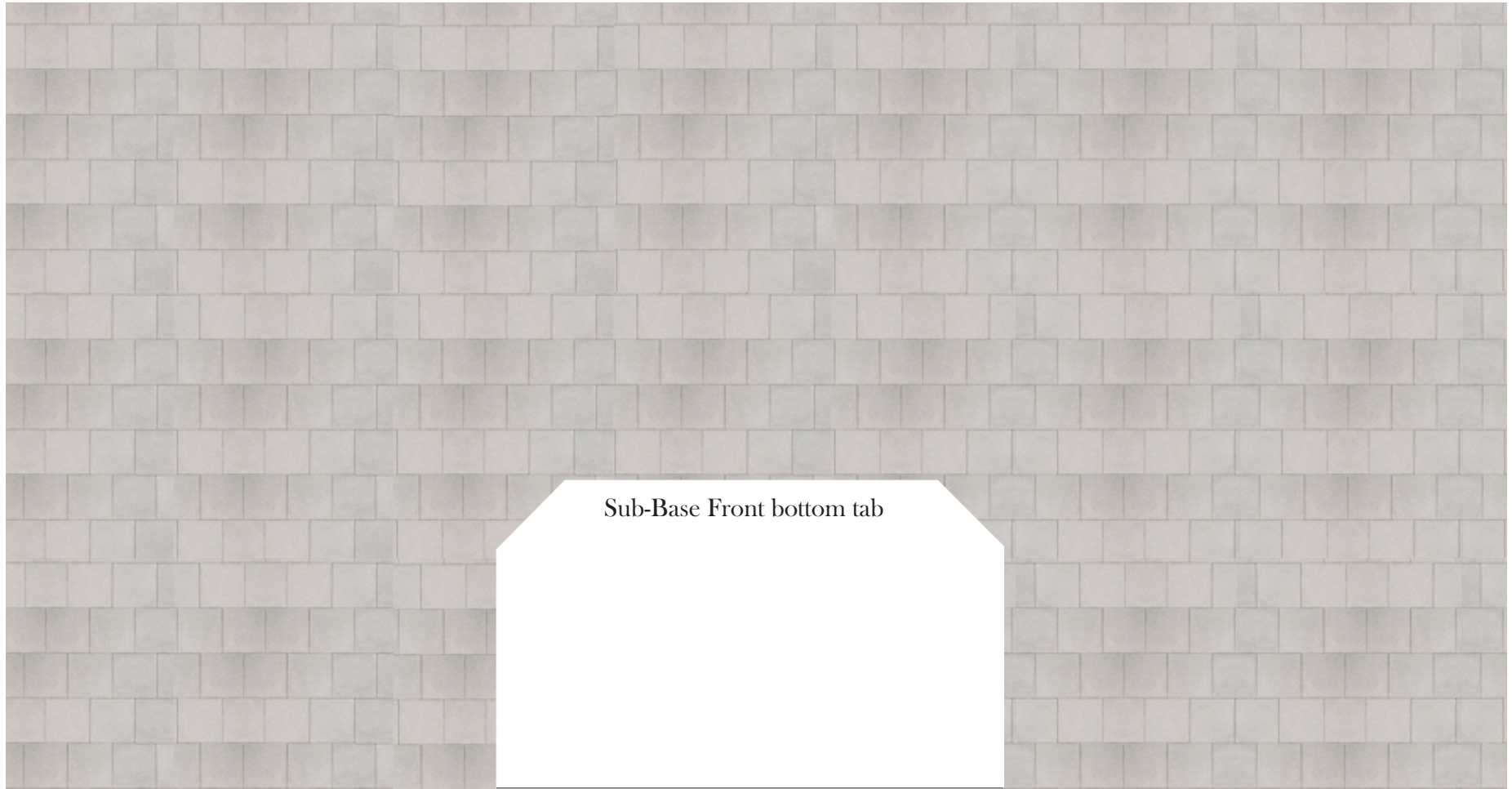
Back Semi-Circle

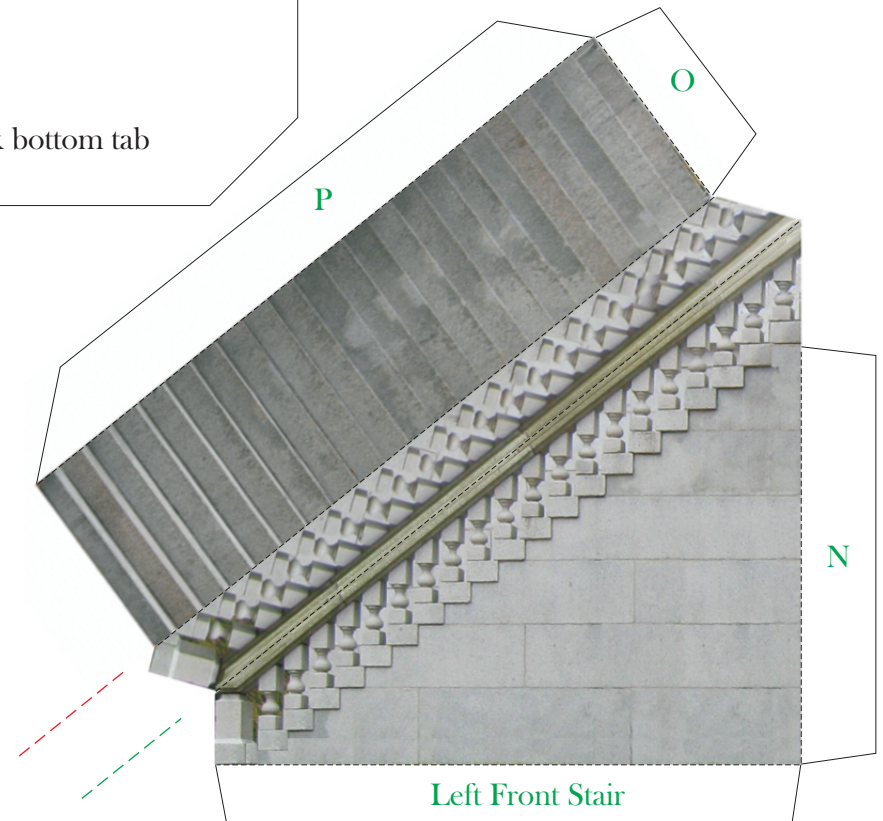
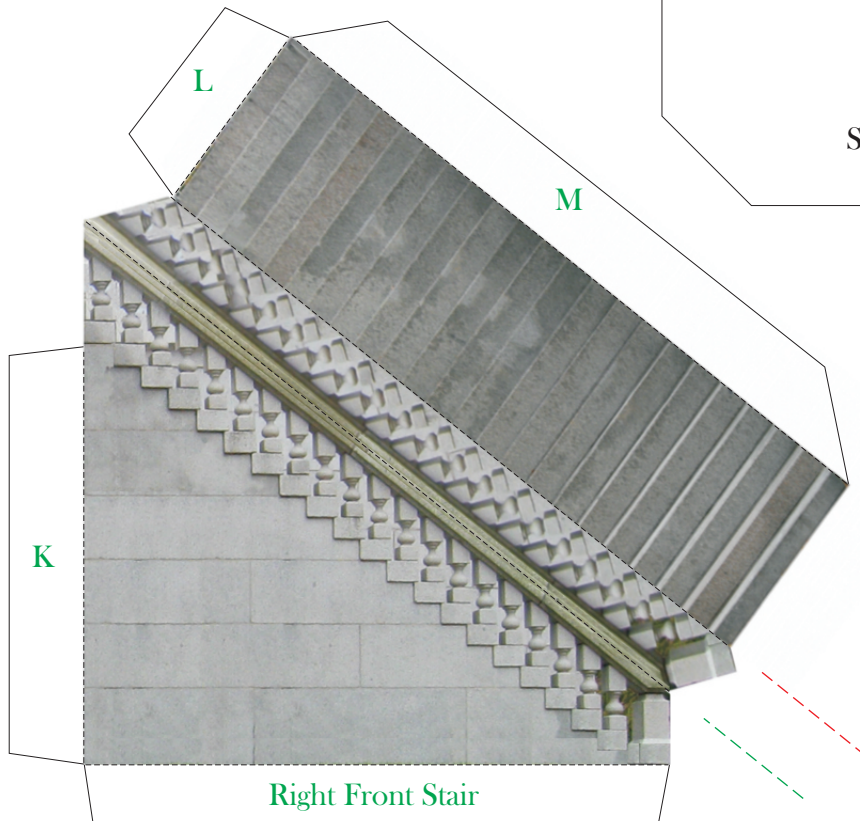
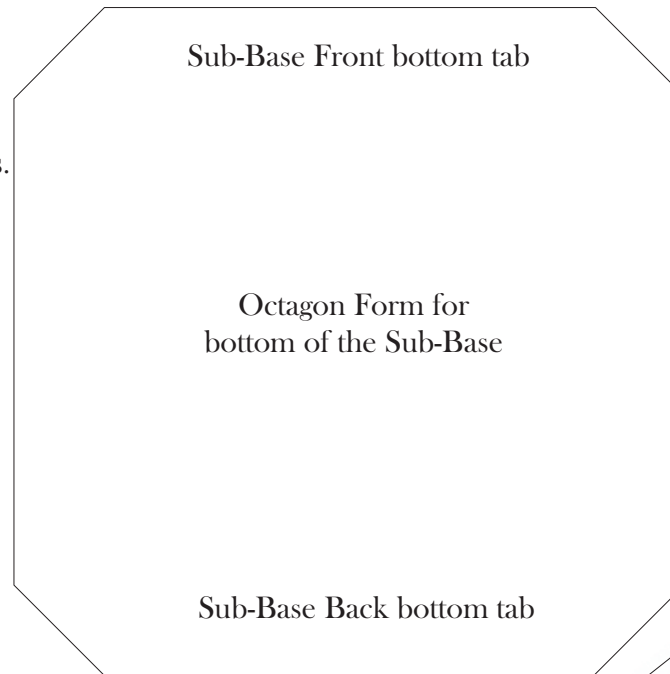

To Assemble Right and Left Front Stairs:

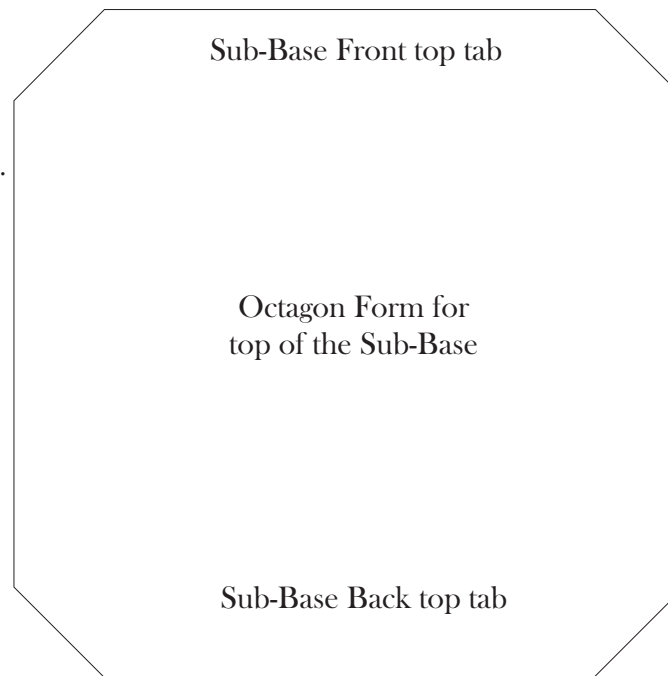
1. Cut out the Right and Left Front Stairs.
2. Fold all dotted lines.
3. Glue the balustrade back-to-back for the Right Front Stairs so it looks the same on both sides.
4. Glue it to the Front Wall and the Front Semi-Circle using tabs K, L, & M.
5. Glue the balustrade back-to-back for the Left Front Stairs so it looks the same on both sides.
4. Glue it to the Front Wall and the Front Semi-Circle using tabs N, O, & P.

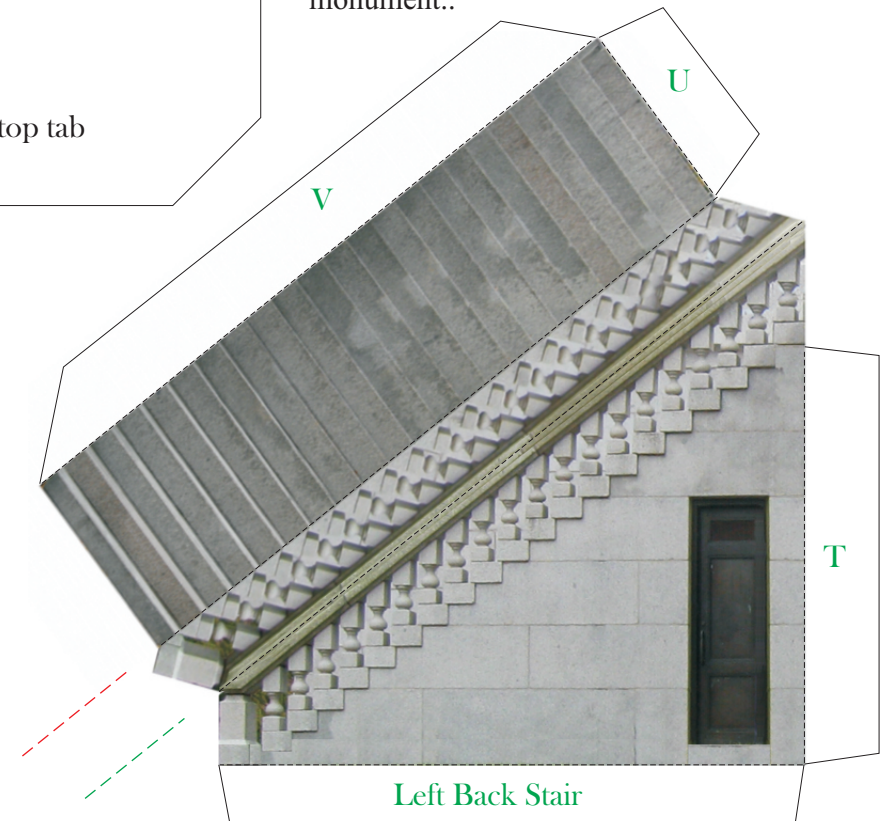
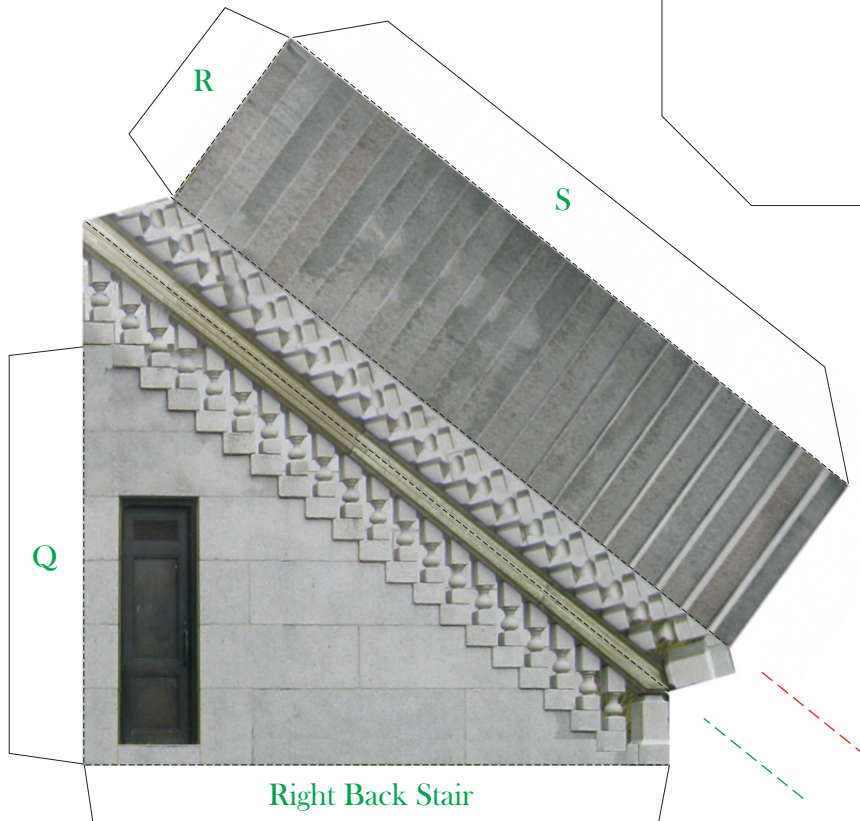
To Assemble Right and Left Back Stairs:

1. Cut out the Right and Left Back Stairs.
2. Fold all dotted lines.
3. Glue the balustrade back-to-back for the Right Back Stairs so it looks the same on both sides.
4. Glue it to the Back Wall and the Back Semi-Circle using tabs Q, R, & S.
5. Glue the balustrade back-to-back for the Left Back Stairs so it looks the same on both sides.
4. Glue it to the Back Wall and the Back Semi-Circle using tabs T, U, & V.

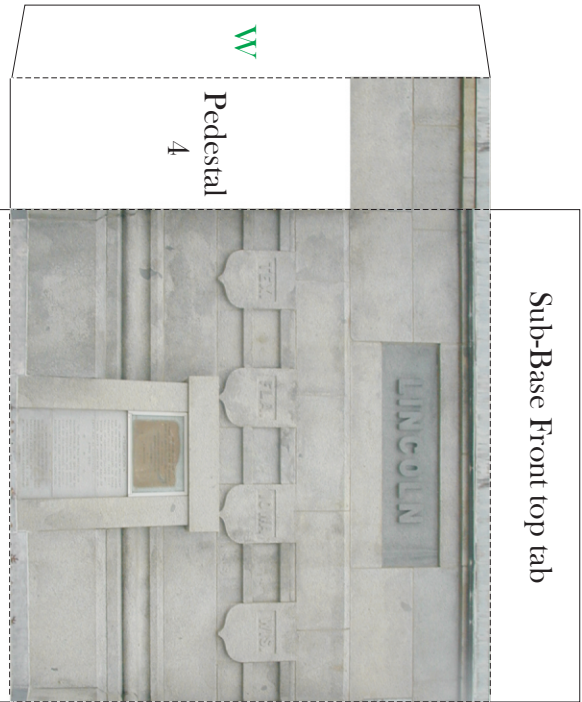


To Assemble the Sub-Base:

1. Cut out the Sub-Base Front and Back pieces.
2. Fold all dotted lines.
3. Glue the 2 pieces together using tabs W & X.
4. Glue the Octagon Form bottom to the Sub-Base bottom tabs to provide the correct shape.
5. Glue the Octagon Form top to the Sub-Base top tabs to provide the correct shape.
4. Glue the assembled Sub-Base to the Main Floor centered over the matching octagon.
5. Glue the Sub-Base Stone Top centered over the Octagon Form top of the Sub-Base. Be sure the Lincoln Pedestal blank space faces the front of the monument..

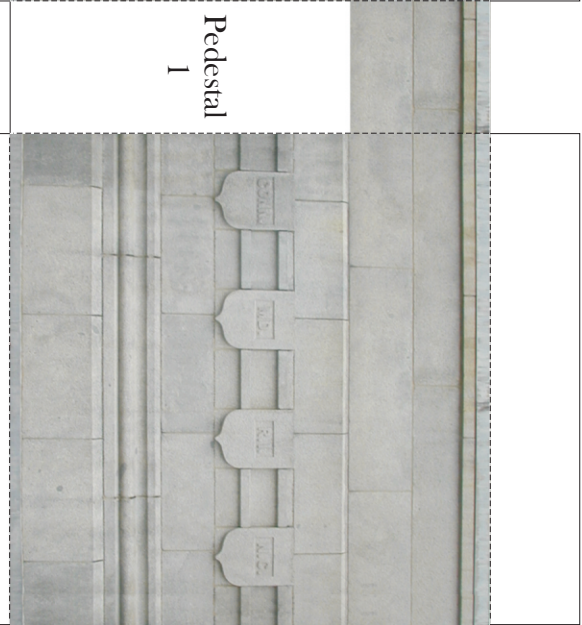

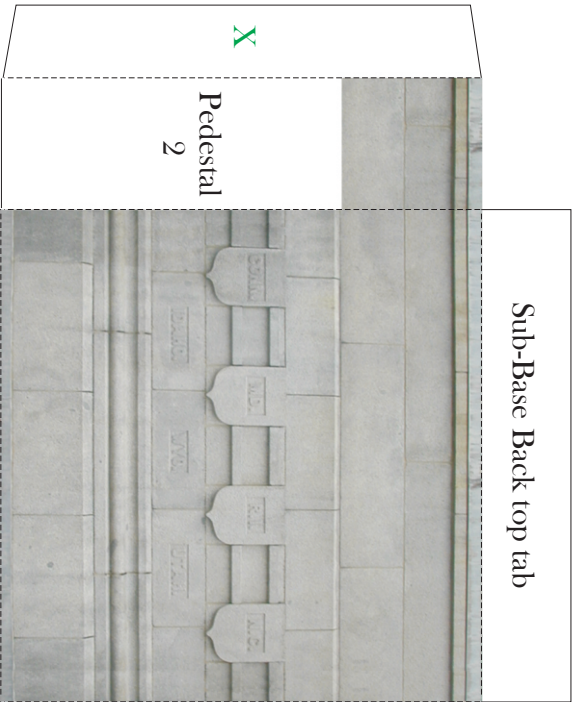


Sub-Base Front top tab

Sub-Base Front bottom tab

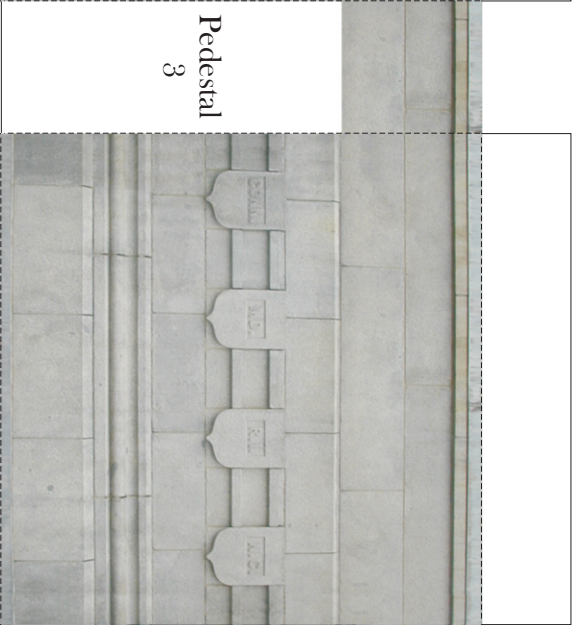


Pedestal 1



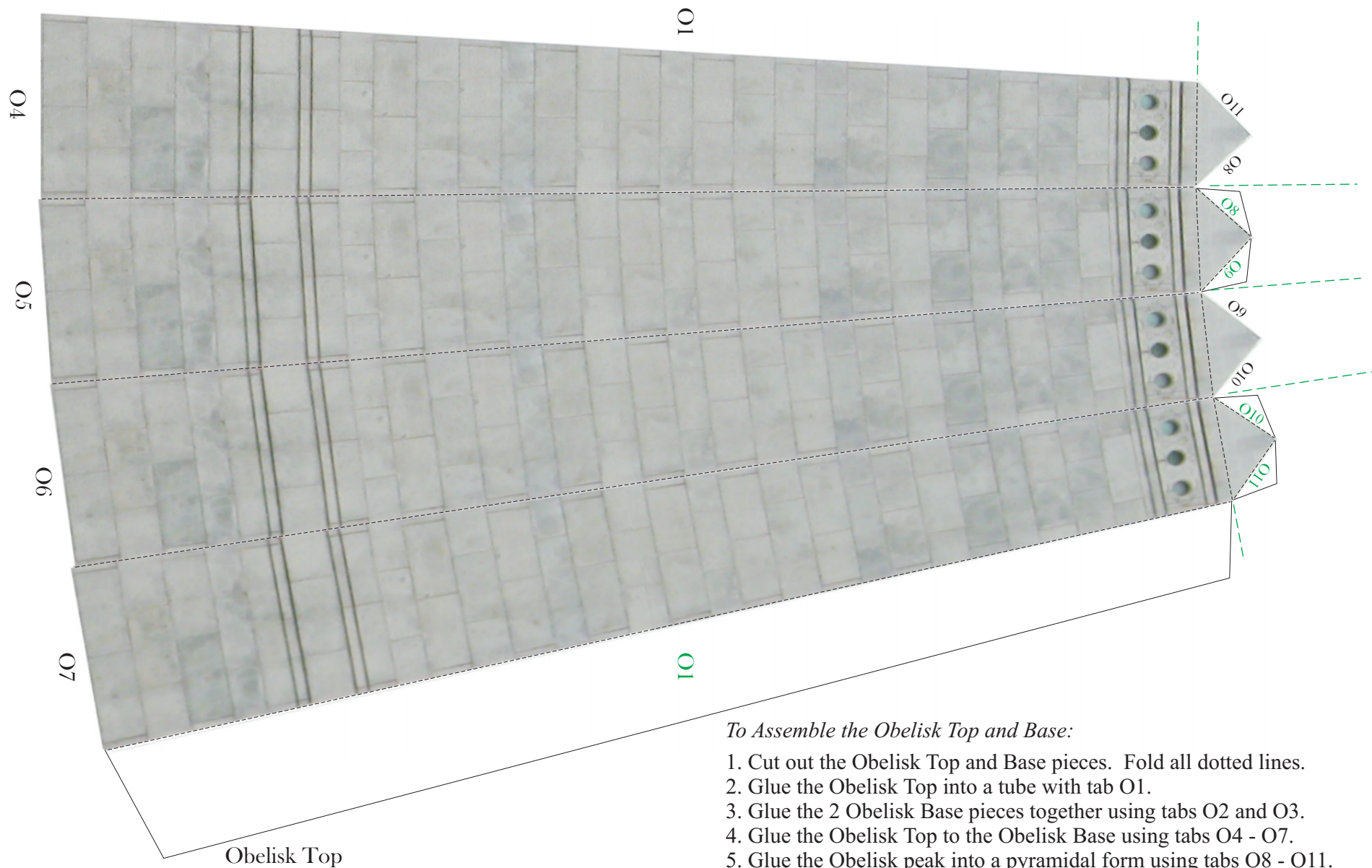
Sub-Base Back top tab

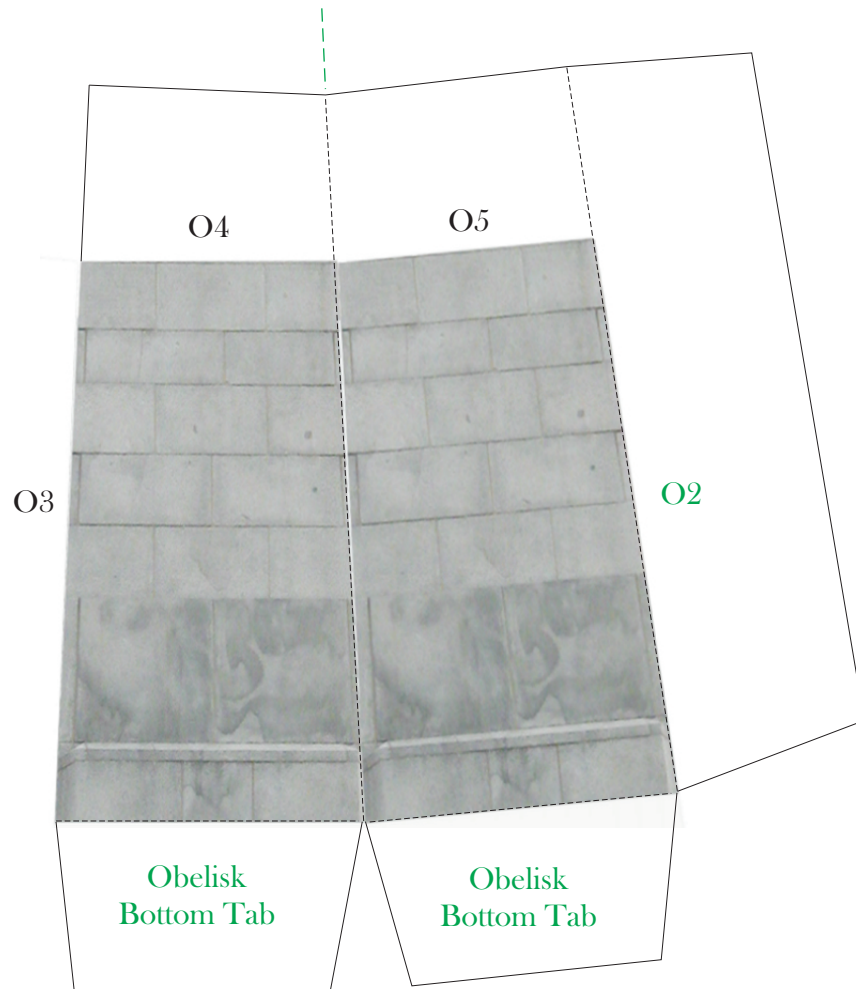
To Assemble the Obelisk Top and Base:

1. Cut out the Obelisk Top and Base pieces. Fold all dotted lines.
2. Glue the Obelisk Top into a tube with tab O1.
3. Glue the 2 Obelisk Base pieces together using tabs O2 and O3.
4. Glue the Obelisk Top to the Obelisk Base using tabs O4 - O7.
5. Glue the Obelisk peak into a pyramidal form using tabs O8 - O11.
6. Glue the Assembled Obelisk centered on the Sub-Base using the bottom tabs.

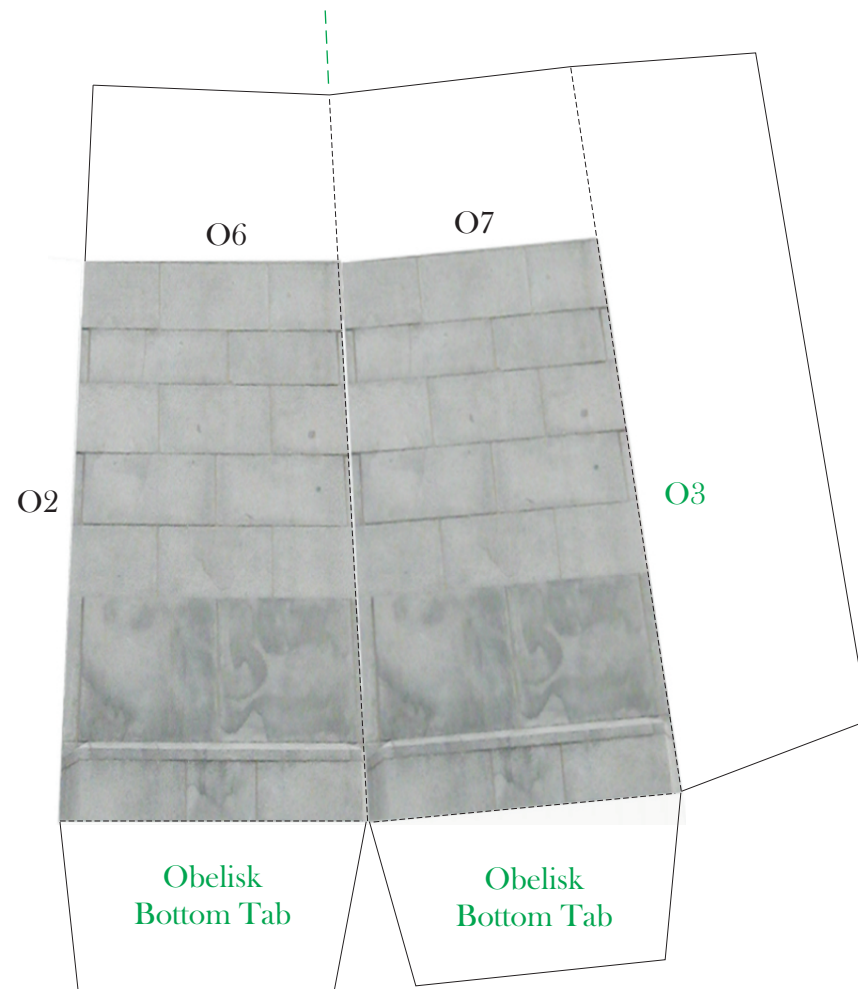
BUILD YOUR OWN LINCOLN SITES

To Assemble the Pedestals 1 thru 4:

1. Cut out Pedestals 1 thru 4. Fold all dotted lines.
2. Cut out the 4 Pedestal Bases and 4 Pedestal Tops. Cut a slit in each Pedestal Top along the white line.
3. Glue Pedestal 1 visible back tab over the hidden back tab to create a cylinder with a flattened backside.
4. Slip one of the Pedestal Bases inside the cylinder and glue to tabs P1a - P1g.
5. Glue one of the Pedestal Tops to the tabs P1h - P1n. Make sure the overhang is uniform and the circular shape is uniform.
6. Repeat steps 3 thru 6 for the remaining Pedestals.

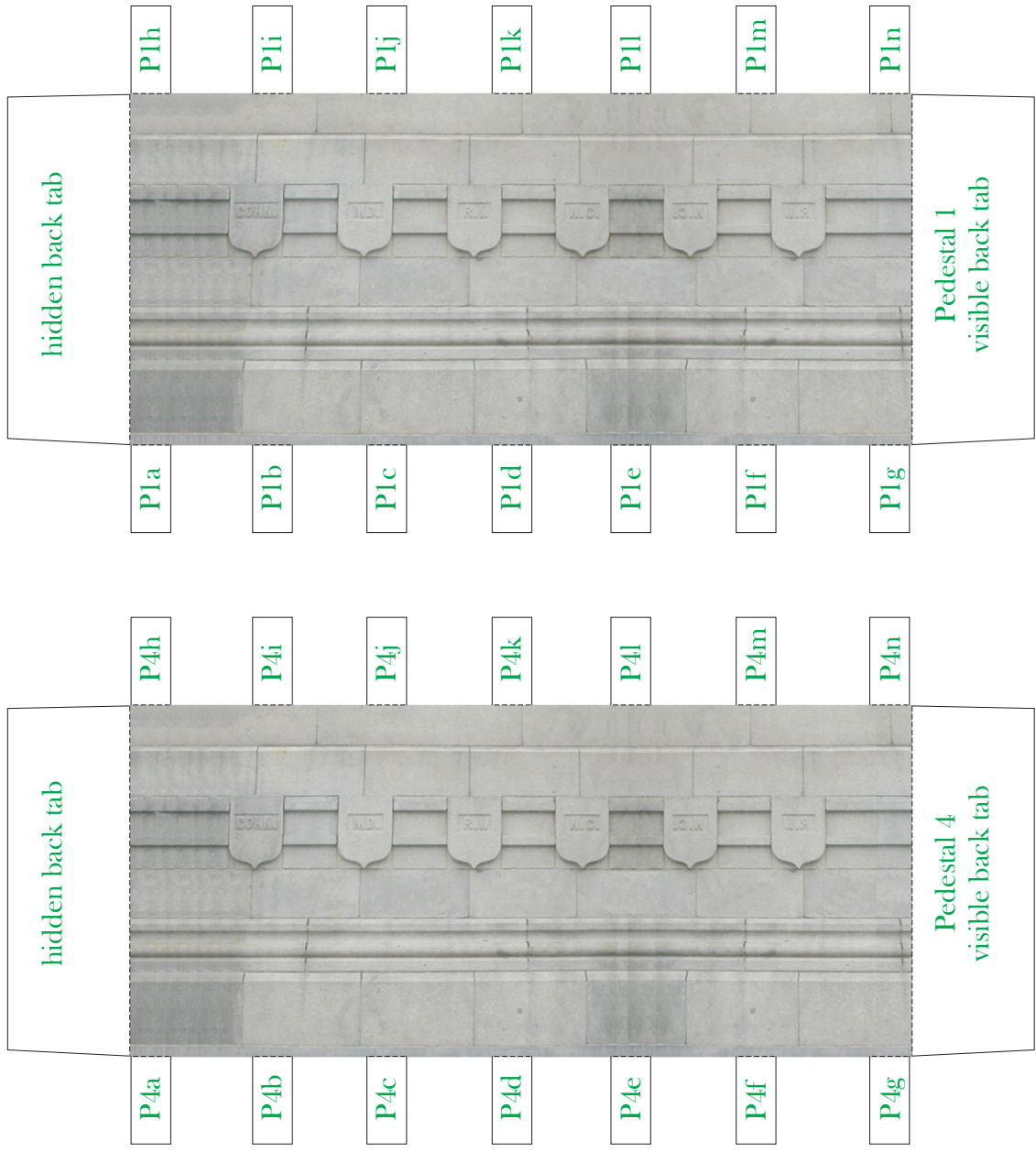


Obelisk Base 1



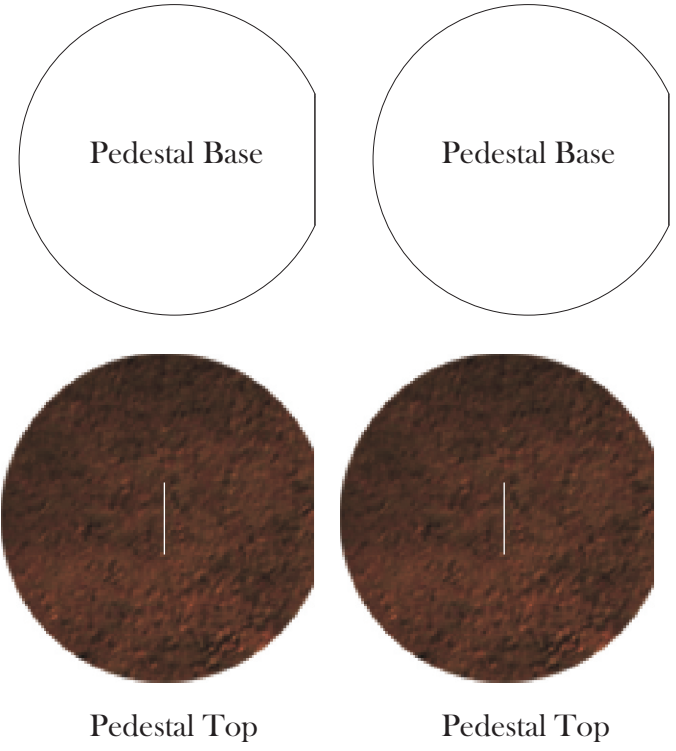
Obelisk Base 2

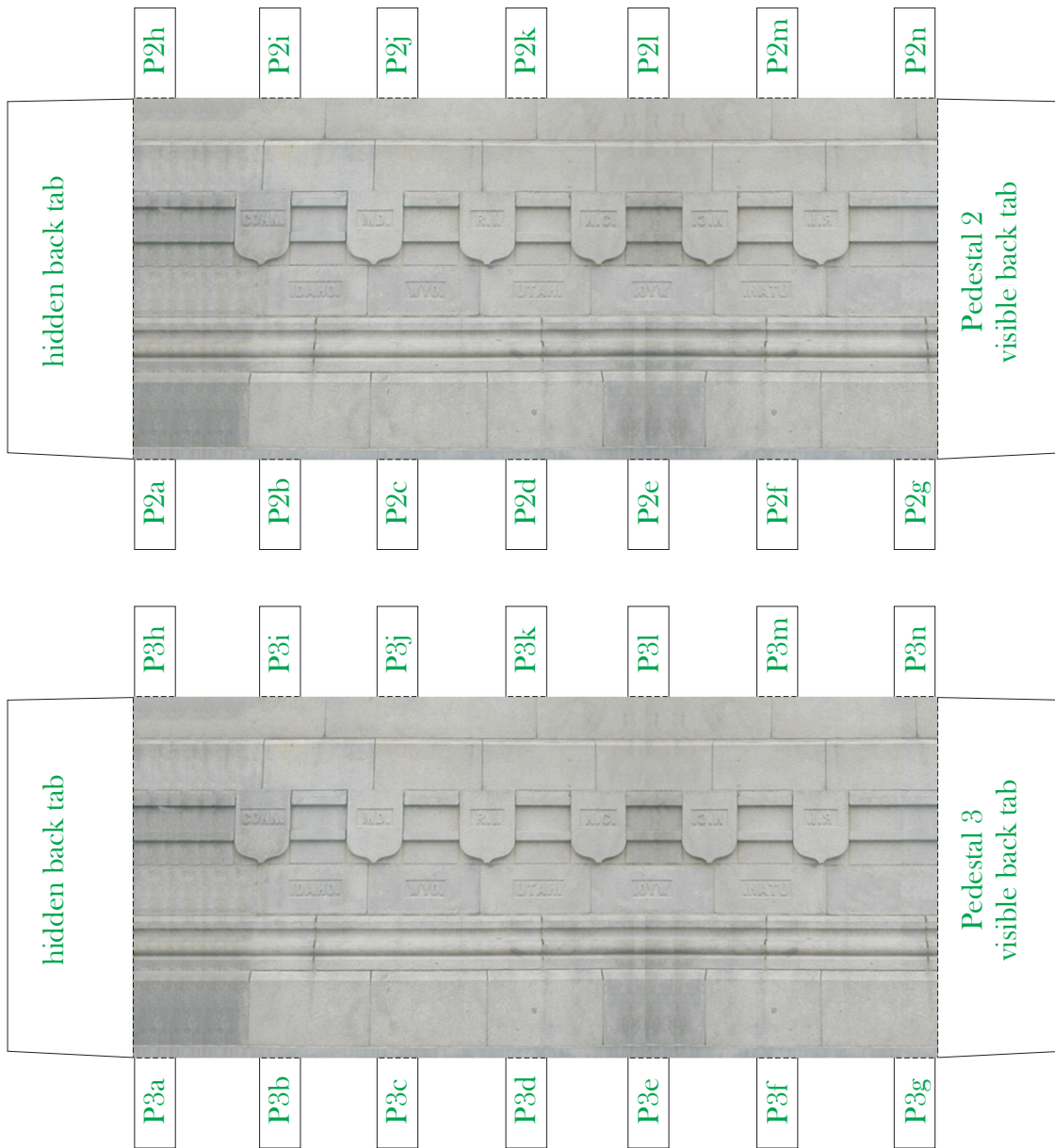


To Assemble Statues 1 thru 4:

1. Cut out Statues 1 thru 4. Cut slits at solid white lines in the center of the dotted fold lines. (Leave Statue number tags attached. They indicate the side of the Statue that faces away from the obelisk and location.)
2. Cut out Statue Tabs 1 thru 4.
3. Insert Statue Tab 1 thru slit in Statue 1. Half the Tab will stick thru.
4. Glue the Statue back to back with the Tab sandwiched between.
5. Insert the Statue Tab thru the slit in Pedestal Top 1. Gluing it in place vertically straight and centered on the Top. Be sure the number tag faces away from the Obelisk.
6. Repeat steps 3 thru 5 for the other 3 Statues.
7. Glue the Pedestals with Statues attached to the corresponding corner of the Sub-Base.
8. Cut away the Statue number tags.

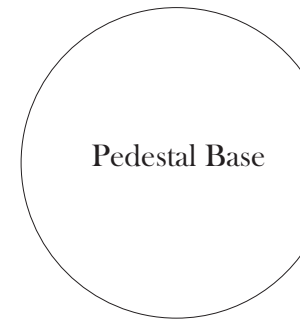

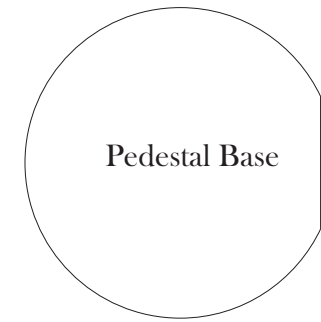


To Assemble the Lincoln Pedestal and Statue:

1. Cut out Lincoln Statue and Pedestal. Fold all dotted lines. Cut a slit at the solid white line on the Pedestal top.
2. Glue the Lincoln Statue back-to-back.
3. Glue the Lincoln Pedestal into a box using tabs L1 - L3.
4. Glue the Lincoln Statue to the Pedestal by inserting the Front tab into the slit cut in the Pedestal top. Front will face toward the eagle on the Pedestal top and away from the Obelisk.
5. Glue the Lincoln Pedestal to the Sub-Base Stone Top.

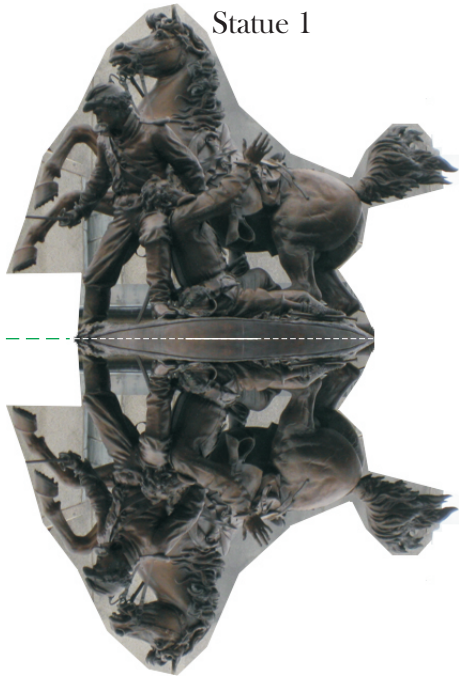

Bust

To Assemble the Lincoln Bust:

1. Cut out Lincoln Bust and Front Patio. Fold all dotted lines.
2. Glue the Lincoln Bust into a box using tabs Lb1 - Lb2.
3. The top at Lb2 will be rounded.
4. Glue tabs Lb3 together to create a base.
5. Glue the Bust to the Front Patio matching up Lb 3.
Lincoln's face will be away from the Tomb.
6. Glue Front Patio to the Front Wall bottom tab where marked.
