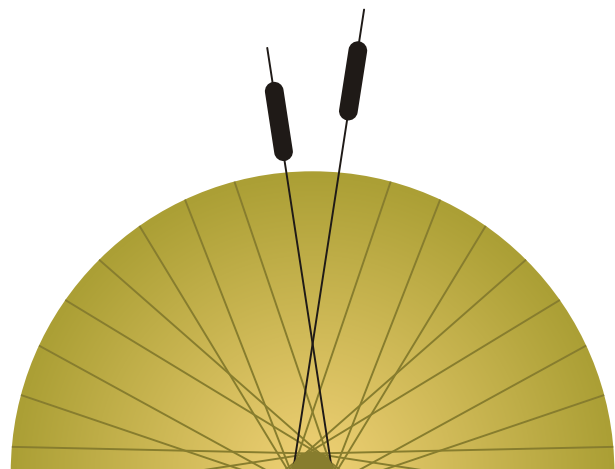
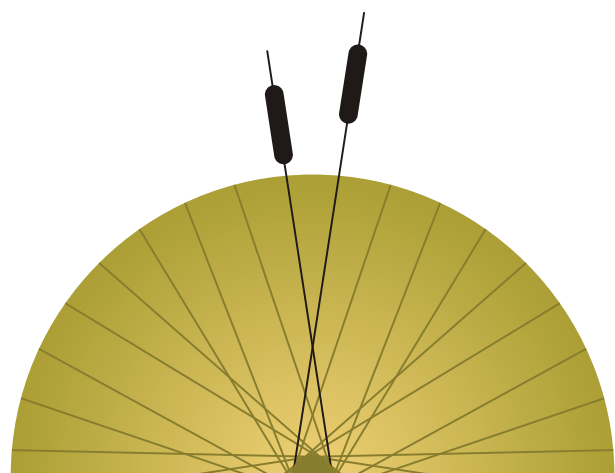


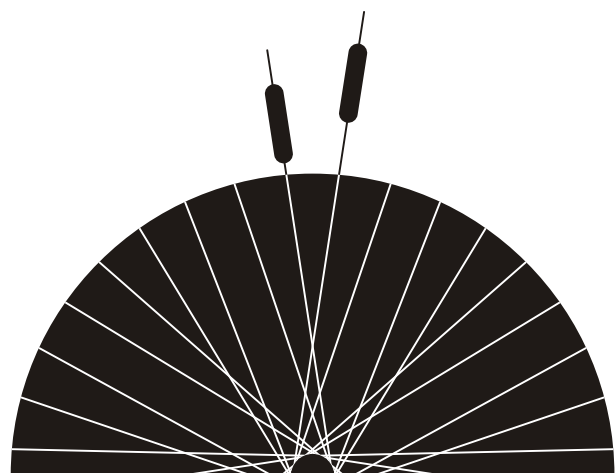

PROPOSED DESIGN

- Remove existing signs.
- Paint wood siding on all facades. Use Sherwin Williams Moody Blue, style 6221.
- Install flush-mounted signs as shown.
- Install sign lighting as shown. Use minimal gooseneck fixtures, such as the Mini Micro Sign Light by B-K Lighting.
