EXISTING CONDITIONS

Existing non-historic door and surround to be removed.

New sign board to be installed over the existing facade. Board can be made of PVC layered with vinyl graphics. Font used is American Typewriter Medium.

Existing lights to be repaired and used to spotlight "printable designs".

Copper window frames can be stripped using a mild chemical stripper. They can also be re painted (SW7073).

> Existing historic door and surround to be painted (SW7073).

> > New vinyl window graphics.

Broken structural glass pieces to be replaced with matching.
