Rosiclare City Park entry sign inspired by the fluor spar mining history of the area. The sign structure is an enlarged mining pick with individual letters supported by the head. The letters themselves can be internally illuminated or lit from below for night-time visibility. In the rare event that the Army Corp of Engineers has to access the area beyond the levy, the entire sign can be temporarily removed from the base and reinstalled afterwards.
