PROPOSED DESIGN - OPTION 2

Long blade canopy with clear-anodized aluminum fascia. Canopy is rectangular above the entry but narrows toward the right edge of the building. Entry flanked by angular glass partitions, set in clear-anodized frames. Large window box, seemingly suspended from the canopy, allows light into the conference room. Business name composed of cast aluminum letters, bottom-rail mounted. Font used is Franklin Gothic Medium. Approximate letter height is 10".
