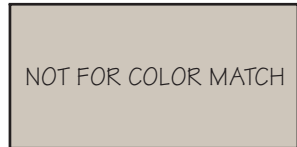

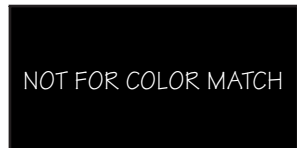

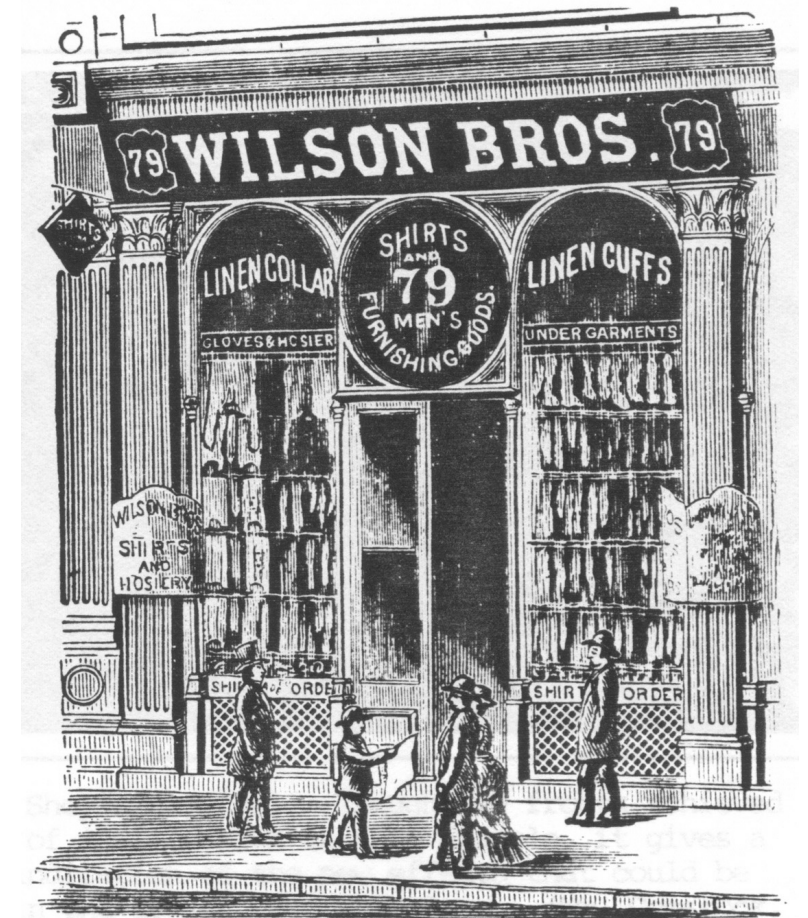


PROPOSED DESIGN

Wood or PVC board layered with vinyl graphics. Image of a silver dollar obverse in the center. Font used is Dickens, with a thicker outline. Colors used are black and silver/pewter. Entire sign to be bolted to masonry joints.
