TREES REMOVED FOR DRAWING CLARITY

SIGNAGE:

Arden's

"Vladimir Script" font. Aluminum with opaque blue-enamel-on-aluminum center. Edge and sides have clear-anodized finish. 3-D letters backed with red neon (channel-set) and mounted away from the brick on pins set into the mortar. Rotated approx. 10 degrees.

FINE FURNITURE

"Ribbon" font. Clear-anodized cast-aluminum letters approx 3' high. Mounted on pins set into the mortar and illuminated by the spots above. Placed about 2' from the aluminum frame and a bit lower than center.

SINCE 1958

"Ribbon" font. Clear-anodized cast-aluminum letters approx 20" high. Mounted on pins set into the mortar and illuminated by the spots above. Placed under Fine Furniture flush right.
