MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT STATE STREET BRIDGE OVER THE KISHWAUKEE RIVER STRUCTURE NUMBER 004-0002 BELVIDERE, BOONE COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has determined that the removal of the State Street Bridge over the Kishwaukce River (SN 004-0002) in Boone County, Illinois will have an adverse effect upon a property determined eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places, and has consulted with the Illinois Historic Preservation Agency (IHPA) and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (Council) pursuant to the regulations (36 CFR Part 800) implementing Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (16 U.S.C. par. 470f), and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) participated in the consultation and has been invited to concur with this Memorandum of Agreement,

NOW, THEREFORE, FHWA, IHPA, and the Council agree that the removal of SN 004-0002 shall be implemented in accordance with the following stipulations in order to take into account the effect of the undertaking on historic properties.

Stipulations

FHWA, in coordination with the IDOT, shall ensure that the following measures are carried out:

- 1. Prior to construction activities, IDOT shall submit to IHPA Level II documentation to the standards of the Illinois Historic American Buildings Survey/Historic American Engineering Record (IL HABS/HAER). The IL HAER recordation number will be BO-1996-1.
- 2. The IDOT will seek a suitable replacement for SN 004-0002 for inclusion on the Illinois Historic Bridge Survey.
- 3. The existing memorial bridge plate will be removed and re-mounted to continue to honor the World War personnel of the Army, Navy, and Marine Corps.

Execution of this Memorandum of Agreement by FHWA and the IHPA, its subsequent acceptance by the Council, and implementation of its terms, demonstrate that FHWA has afforded the Council an opportunity to comment on this undertaking and its effects on historic properties and that FHWA has taken into account the effects of the undertaking on historic properties.
