## MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN SCOTT AIR FORCE BASE AND

THE ILLINOIS STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICE SUBMITTED TO THE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON HISTORIC PRESERVATION PURSUANT TO 36 CFR SECTION 800.5(E)(4) REGARDING THE DEMOLITION OF BUILDINGS 58 AND 59

WHEREAS, the United States Air Force, Scott Air Force Base, Commander 375<sup>th</sup> AW (Scott) has determined that the remediation of RCRA hazardous waste sites will have an adverse effect on Buildings 58 and 59 which are contributing structures in the Scott Field Historic District, a district which is eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places, and

WHEREAS, Scott has consulted with the Illinois State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) in accordance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act, 16 U.S.C. Section 470 (NHPA), and its implementing regulations (36 CFR Part 800) to resolve the adverse effect of the demolition of Buildings 58 and 59 and

NOW, THEREFORE, Scott and the SHPO agree that, upon acceptance of this MOA by the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (Council) and upon Scott's decision to proceed with the demolition, Scott shall ensure that the following stipulations are implemented in order to take into account the effects of the demolition on historic properties.

## **STIPULATIONS**

Scott shall ensure that the following stipulations are implemented:

- Prior to the demolition, Scott shall document Buildings 58 and 59 in accordance with Level III of the Illinois Historic American Buildings Survey/Historic American Engineering Record (IL HABS/HAER) Standards.
- 2. IL HABS recordation numbers will be S-1997-1 for Building 58 and S-1997-2 for Building 59.
- 3. Scott, through competitive bid, may award the recordation contract to a consultant of its choice, provided the consultant is qualified to perform the work and agrees to meet IL HABS/HAER Standards.
- 4. The SHPO will review the completed IL HABS documentation and accept the final submittal in writing in accordance with IL HABS/HAER Standards.

Execution of the Memorandum of Agreement by Scott and the SHPO, its subsequent acceptance by the Council, and implementation of its terms evidence that Scott has afforded the Council an opportunity to comment on the demolition of Buildings 58 and 59 and its effects on historic properties, and that Scott has taken into account the effects of the undertaking on historic properties.
