WHEREAS, the Agreement was executed on December 6, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Village of River Forest (Village) and the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO) propose to amend the Agreement to remove Stipulations II. Mitigation-Salvage, due to conditions of the Building and the infeasibility of salvaging the colored art glass windows as stated in the Agreement: "The Village shall make reasonable attempts to salvage the colored art glass windows and stone screen bricks for potential use on the site or other village properties. The Village will also contact and coordinate with Landmarks Illinois about possible reuse of these features."

WHEREAS, in accordance with Stipulation VII., "This Agreement may be amended when such an amendment is agreed to in writing by all signatories. The amendment will be effective on the date a copy is signed by all of the signatories."

NOW, THEREFORE, The Village, DCEO, and SHPO agree that the Agreement shall be amended to omit Stipulations II. Mitigation-Salvage from the Agreement.
